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# Siberian Spring: Baikal Awakening

End of April - beginning of May is the unique spring time when Baikal is getting rid off the ice cover. Spring is a period of change, ice begins to move, greens break through melted snow and the air is completely unusual, but so pleasant. Tubular ice crumbles like glass from any movement, and the noise of the awakening aikal does not stop for a minute. The spring on Lake Baikal is filled with Olkhon's yellow fields, beautiful clouds and white ice floes migrating through blue waters, becoming part of them. Travel to Baikal in May to see and listen the Baikal Awakening.

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# Day 1. Arrival to Baikal

Arrive Irkutsk in the morning. Departure to Olkhon Island. The road will take about 5 hours. Crossing to the island by ferry.

Check-in in a comfy local guest-house and time for lunch.

The beginning of May is the moment when spring at last comes to Baikal, and the ice on the lake is actively melting.

In the evening we'll admire the views on the spring ice breakup from the top photo spots and meet Sunset and Cape Burkhan with its mysterious "Sarge", ritual wooden pillars of Buryat and Yakut people.

They symbolize the "tree of life," the roots in the lower worlds of demons and branches in the heavens where the Noyons live. Sarge are bound with multicolored patches of fabrics.

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## Day 2. Olkhon Island

Today, we'll explore the sights of Olkhon Island

On the way, we'll also make stops at such expressive landscapes like the double rock of Love, the white-rock Cape Sagan-Khushun on the North of the island and Cape Mare's Head on the South of Olkhon, plus we'll go down to several sandy beaches. Picnic in nature with a view of Lake Baikal is also a must!

We'll meet sunset at Shamanka Rock, Cape Burkhan, where the Baikal ruler lives according to local beliefs.

taking ride in UAZ van. During the way you will make numerous panoramic photo stops. Olkhon is a place of power in Buryats beliefs, and the Island is literally overflowing with objects of shamanism, like sacred pillars with tied ribbons.













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## Day 3. Tazheran Steppe

Today we'll return to the mainland. After taking a ferry from Olkhon Island we'll move to our cozy eco-lodge accommodation located on the shore of the Maloye More (Small Sea) Strait that separates Olkhon from the mainland.

After check into comfortable wooden houses with en-suite facilities just a few meters away from the lake shores we'll have a 3 hours ATV ride along the coast of the strait end vast expanses of Tazheran steppe.

Drive up to the mountains for a sunset photo session at the observation point with the best views over Maloye More Strait and Baikal. The location itself is famous for being the old shamanism center and we will even see a few artefacts.

During dinner we'll have the opportunity to taste traditional Siberian cuisine, optional Banya in the evening.























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### Day 4. Culture Mix

Today, we will take a closer look at the cultural heritage of the people living on Lake Baikal -Russians and Buryats.

First, we'll move go to the Buryat settlement Ust-Ordynsky, where you'll have a chance to come into the real yurt and be greeted by ancient traditions. Buryats will introduce you to national folklore - songs and dances, throat singing. Meet the Buryat shaman. The landlady will teach you to cook the Buryat national dish - buuza. Have Buryat breakfast.

Then, we'll make a stop at Taltsy Open Air Siberian Culture Museum. The exposition features wooden buildings brought from all over Siberia! Right now, 40 landmarked buildings and 8000 artifacts dated by XVII-XIX centuries are presented as part of the exhibition. Here you will see the traditional folk-show and have a lunch.

Evening arrival to the village of Listvyanka, located on the shore of Lake Baikal. Check into local hotel for overnight stay/

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## Day 5. Listvyanka

Visit Baikal Museum, Shaman Rock, St. Nicholas church and a Fish Market.

Baikal Museum is a splendid museum where information about lake Baikal wildlife is kept, studied and exhibited: including the origins of the lake, the endemic flora and fauna from the surface of the lake to its maximum depth, an excellent model of the lake, etc.

Shaman Rock is a natural boundary between the deepest lake in the world and the only river that flows out of the lake—the Angara river.

In the evening, enjoy Lake Baikal boat cruise (option for group tours). During the cruise, you will enjoy the vastness of the lake and magnificent landscapes, feel the power and energy of the Siberian land awakening after a long winter.


# Day 6. Irkutsk City our & Farewell

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


