Day 2: History & Art

Half-day (4 hours) guided tour in St. Petersburg.

Travel back in time by stepping on board the memorial ship Aurora. On the night of October 25-26 1917, it fired a blank shot at the Winter Palace (then the residence of the Provisional Government), giving the signal to the rebellious workers, soldiers and sailors of the city to storm the palace. That moment triggered a dramatic episode in Russia's history and was the start of the Revolution and over 70 years of Communist leadership.

Enjoy the huge cultural heritage at the State Russian Museum, the world's largest depository of Russian fine art, and a must-see in St. Petersburg. It is also one of the largest museums in the country.

Day 3: The Hermitage & Iconic Landmarks

Full-day (8 hours) guided tour in St. Petersburg.

Day 4: The Catherine Palace

Day (6 hours) guided tour to Pushkin/Tsarskoye Selo (30 km south of St. Petersburg).

A splendid example of Russian Baroque, Catherine Palace delights its visitors with sumptuous Great Hall and Golden Enfilade of staterooms, including the world-famous Amber Room. The exposition of the palace covers almost 300-years history of the former imperial summer residence.

A widely acknowledged masterpiece of garden and landscape art, Catherine Park includes variously styled pavilions, bridges, monuments and exotic garden structures that carry visitors away to other countries and bygone ages.

The name "Kremlin" means "fortress inside a city", this construction had to protect the city from enemies. The Moscow Kremlin acquired the status of a sacral symbol representing the power of the great country.





Day 8: Moscow Tour

Day 9: Moscow Tour

Full-day (8 hours) guided tour in Moscow.

Visit the Izmaylovo Kremlin. As the symbol of the Russian state, the Kremlin in Moscow's Red Square is famed and celebrated. But there is a second, less known Kremlin in the northeast part of the city. The Kremlin in the city's Izmailovo District is an unexpected, fairytale-like cultural wonderland.


Next take a tour to Exhibition Complex Bunker 42, a once-secret military complex, bunker, and Spare Long-Range Aviation Command Post (ET-42) in Moscow near the underground Moscow Metro station Taganskaya. It has an area of 7,000 square metres (75,000 sq ft) and is situated at a depth of 65 metres (213 ft) below ground.

Visit Chambers of the Romanov Boyars. This museum exhibit authentic historical items, including 16th- and 17th-century weapons, books, engravings, writing implements, chests and other objects.

Day 10: Moscow Tour

Half-day (4 hours) guided tour in Moscow.

Enjoy the tour to Kolomenskoye Museum-Reserve. It is a former royal estate situated several kilometres to the southeast of the city centre of Moscow, Russia, on the ancient road leading to the town of Kolomna (hence the name). The 390-hectare scenic area overlooks the steep banks of the Moskva River. It became a part of Moscow in the 1960s. During the early Soviet period, under the initiative of architect and restorer Pyotr Baranovsky, old wooden buildings and various artefacts were transported to Kolomenskoye from different parts of the USSR for preservation, so currently Kolomenskoye Park hosts an impressive set of different constructions and historical objects.






