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Day 1: Arrival, eco-lodge in tundra, Northern lights hunting

Arrival at Murmansk. We recommend a flight arriving at Murmansk at noon.

Our driver will meet you at the airport and transfer to the eco-lodge on Tuloma river (about 1 hour ride). Check-in at 2-3 bedroom deluxe house (subject to availability). Welcome to enjoy the Russian Arctic trip!

Relax in a Russian banya with Banchik.

After dinner prepare for your Northern Lights Hunt tonight at 8-10 pm (or the other night if the forecasts hints on better chances). Our ground team is constantly monitoring the forecast. We travel to tundra to the locations where Aurora is best seen.





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Day 2: Teriberka Tour & The Ocean

Today we reach the shores of the Atlantic Ocean (Barents Sea), 75km drive. Fascinating Arctic nature is the best feature, although there are also plenty of historical and cultural highlights to visit.

Parts of the arctic flora, fauna and the splendid northern landscape, recently appeared in the famous Russian movie "Leviafan" and have started to attract more and more visitors. Here you will find yourself in the lost world on the shores of the Arctic Ocean.

Old wooden ships cemetery, beautiful sand beaches frozen waterfalls falling into the Ocean, "dragon eggs" beachl, abandoned historical part of the village, waterfall, battery of coastal defense, observation posts and strengthening of WWII - we will use snowmobiles to get to some of the attractions to make the best photos.

Local cafes serve great seafood including fresh crab.

Transfer to the Arctic Igloo. Dinner will be served in your half-glass dome. Otional Japanese bath (pre-booking is recommended).



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Day 3: Husky park / Lovozero

Breakfast, check out.

Transfer to Lovozersky tundras, the heart of Kola Peninsula and the second highest mountainous terrain of the area. After 2 hours driving, we will use snowmobiles to reach the area. Check-in into 2-bedroom secluded Saami house with sky camera to watch the Northern Lights. Winter apparel is provided.

Visit husky park, where you will get acquainted with the breed of these sled dogs, learn about their breeding, communicate, play and make pictures with Husky. Ride a sledge through magnificent Lovozersky tundras.

After delicious lunch with local specialties, enjoy snowmobiling safari (2 hours) across endless tundra.

In the evening, enjoy a unique experience, dinner in a glass dome. Please note that the dinner may be arranged the following night - we aim to provide the best experience and thus this activity is a weather dependant. We will choose the night with the best Northern Lights forecast.







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Day 4: Ice fishing and Saami village

Breakfast.

Try something truly Arctic, an ice fishing! It is a fun and popular northern type of entertainment. We will use fresh fish to prepare a tasty picnic.

Take a guided tour around the Saami village.

Get to know about traditional Saami way of life and wildlife of the area. Feed a deer, skate on a reindeer sleigh - feel yourself Saami! Late lunch serving traditional Saami meals will be served in a "chum".

Overnight in your tundra house.







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Day 5: City tour and Departure

Breakfast

Return to Murmansk. Have a city tour with your guide. Murmansk is the largest city in the world north of the Arctic Circle. Founded in 1915 as a supply port in World War I, it was a base for the British, French, and American expeditionary forces against the Bolsheviks in 1918.

Murmansk played an important role as a Russian trade link with the Allies during the Second World War II. Various supplies were brought to the city with the help of the Arctic convoys. Murmansk was heavily damaged during the war. It was restored in the beginning of the 1950ies.

We will visit the monument to the Defenders of the Polar Region (Alyosha), fragment of conning tower of nuclear submarine «Kursk» and the Lighthouse — a memorial dedicated to the memory of sailors who died in peacetime and enjoy a beautiful panoramic view to Murmansk and the Kola bay from viewpoint.

Transfer to the airport for departure flight. We recommend booking evening flight.
