Morning: Walking trip to the Winter Palace and the Hermitage guided tour.

Today, you visit one of the most important sites in Russian history and heritage, the worldfamous palace of the Hermitage, the former residence of the Royal Family.

<u>The Hermitage today</u> is one of the largest museums in the world, founded in 1764; its collection includes over 2.7 mln items. Our experienced guide will bring the museum to life to her knowledge.

Your guide will take you for a lunch in a local bistro, "stolovaya" where you can try traditional Russian food.

Then, take a tour to see the city's iconic landmark: Isaac Cathedral, Kazan Cathedral, and visit the Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood — one of the most powerful constructions in Russian Orthodox Christian architecture; an absolutely enthralling must-see and a place where Alexander II was fatally wounded by an archists in 1881.

Enjoy a romantic 2-hour cruise down the canals of St. Petersburg, and see some of the city's monuments on the banks of the River Neva, all beautifully illuminated for the evening. Experience the thrilling spectacle of the drawbridges in full operation.

Gardens and Parks are spread over more than four hundred hectares, and include thirty-one amazing museums and beautiful Versailles-style gardens. In summer, the Peterhof is especially good thanks to its famous fountains which run naturally.

Take a guided tour to the Tretyakov State Art Gallery, one of the two largest collections of the Russian art. The other one is the Russian Museum in St. Petersburg.

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Chambers of the Romanov Boyars

The family country estate of Romanov Boyars (15th-17thcenturies) was restored in the 19th century by order of Alexander I, which happened to be the first scientific restoration undertaken in Moscow. The Museum exhibits authentic historical items, including 16th- and 17th-century weapons, books, engravings, writing implements, chests and other objects. This is Russia's only museum introducing visitors to Moscow boyars' patriarchal ways of life in the 16th and 17th centuries.

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Kolomenskoye is a former royal estate situated several kilometers to the southeast of the city center of Moscow. The 390 hectare scenic area overlooks the steep banks of the Moskva River. During the early Soviet period, under the initiative of architect and restorer Pyotr Baranovsky, old wooden buildings and various artifacts were transported to Kolomenskoye from different parts of the USSR for preservation, so currently Kolomenskoye Park hosts an impressive set of different constructions and historical objects.

Guided tour to UNESCO World Heritage Site, Kremlin of Kazan. Built by Ivan the Terrible on the ruins of the palace of the Kazan Khanate that he destroyed, the Kremlin of Kazan reflects the ethnic mix of Tatars and Russians, Muslims and Christians, that merged into one nation centuries ago.

During our 2 days tour in Kazan you will visit also: Kazan Arena, Millennium Bridge, Tatar Sloboda, Mardzhani Mosque,Kaban Lake, Bogoroditsky Monastery, National Museum, Peter and Paul Cathedral, Bauman Street, Freedom Square.

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Ekaterinburg is the official border between Europe and Asia. You can even travel several times from Europe to Asia and back and of course take a photo standing in two parts of the world simultaneously!



Take a look at the city's main religious institution – Church of All Saints and visit the Ipatiev House – the late Tsar's last resort. Ekaterinburg is most known as a place where the last Romanov Tsar was assassingted after the Revolution.

> Here you can also visit the residence of KGB, Gorodok Chekistov, the largest in Russia museum of semi-precious stone that contains a wonderful collection of stone mosaics and carvings and the largest in Russia open-air military museum.

Irkutsk has a rich history that dates back to 17th century. After the Decembrist Revolt of 1825, many Russian artists, officers, and nobles were sent into exile to Siberia for their part in the revolt against Tsar Nicholas. Irkutsk became the major centre of intellectual and social life for these exiles. You will see many of their wooden houses, adorned with ornate, hand-carved decorations.

Naadam is a traditional festival in Mongolia. The festival is also locally termed "eriin gurvan naadam" — "the three games of men". The games are Mongolian wrestling, horse racing, and archery, and are held throughout the country during midsummer.

In 2010, Naadam was inscribed on the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity of UNESCO.

Day 19: NAADAM festival



Naadam is the most widely watched festival among Mongols and is believed to have existed for centuries in one fashion or another. It has its origin in the activities, such as military parades and sporting competitions such as archery, horse riding and wrestling, that followed the celebration of various occasions, including weddings or spiritual gatherings. It later served as a way to train soldiers for battle and was also connected to Mongols' nomadic lifestyle.

Day 20: Hugnu Khan Mt. National Park

- After lunch, take a short drive to Uvgun Monastery in the national park through the semi-desert and the interesting Rocky Mountains in beautiful Mountain View

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 In the late afternoon, we will visit a local nomadic family and meet nomads, explore their nomadic lifestyle which has not changed for centuries
 Overnight stay in the park camp

Hugnu Khan National Park is a picturesque area of the Rocky Mountains, semi-desert, Gobi sand dunes and steppes all in one location represents three different natural zones. There is ideal for hiking, wildlife observation, and photography.



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Day 21: Karakorum

- After breakfast, short drive to Elsen tasarkhai magnificent sand dunes
- Continue driving to Karakorum and Erdenezuu Monastery
- Lunch
- After lunch, we will visit the museum of Karakorum and the symbolic ruins of the ancient city of Mongol Empire, which was the largest configuous empire in World history
- Also visit the magnificent and the oldest Buddhist Monastery complex of Erdene Zuu, built in the 16th century, with 108 stupas. Here you can see interesting listen to monk chanting Buddhist sutras
- After exploring the monastery, we will drive to Ugii Lake
 Stay overnight at tourist Ger camp near the lake

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Elsen tasarkhai magnificent sand dunes are surrounded by hills with willow trees, streams and bushes, appear as a small desert in the center of the country. This sand dune is 80 km long and the widest part of the sand dune is 9-10 km. The sand dunes are the perfect place for camel riding. We will discover this magnificent place on camelback. Mongolia is home to 2/3 of the two-humped Bactrian camels in the world.

Day 22: Hustai National Park

- Then we will take a short drive to see for wild horse Takhi

- Overnight stay in Ulaanbaatar

Hustai National Park is a home to the Mongolian wild horse known as Przewalski horse (takhi) with a unique landscape that features mountain and steppe.



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General information

✓ In fact, there is no train called the 'Trans-Siberian Express', rather there are many trains going daily eastbound and westbound across Russia, connecting to Mongolia and then to China. You will be surprised by the scale of the system connecting together the world's largest country, thus being a bridge between Asia and Europe. 
