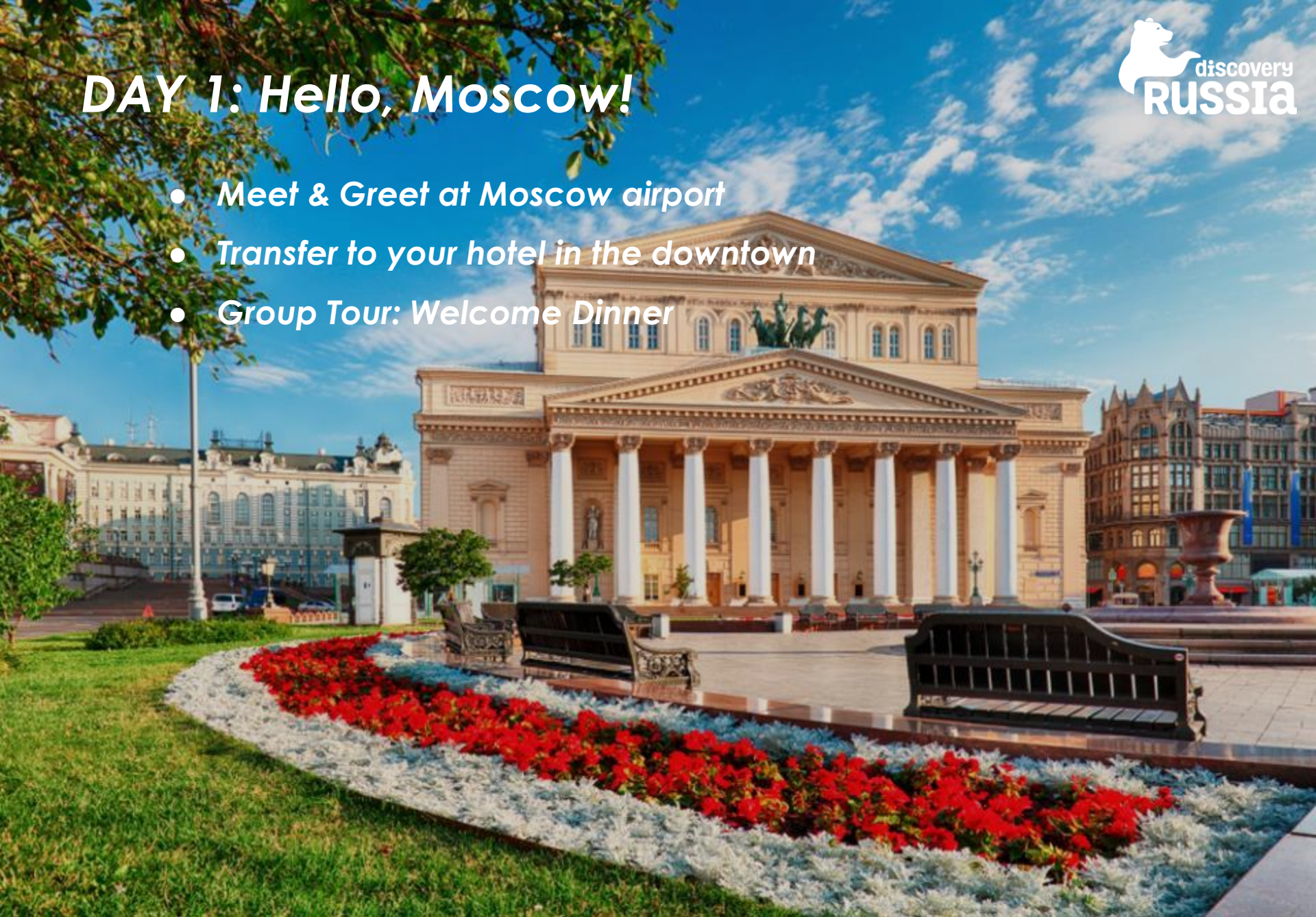

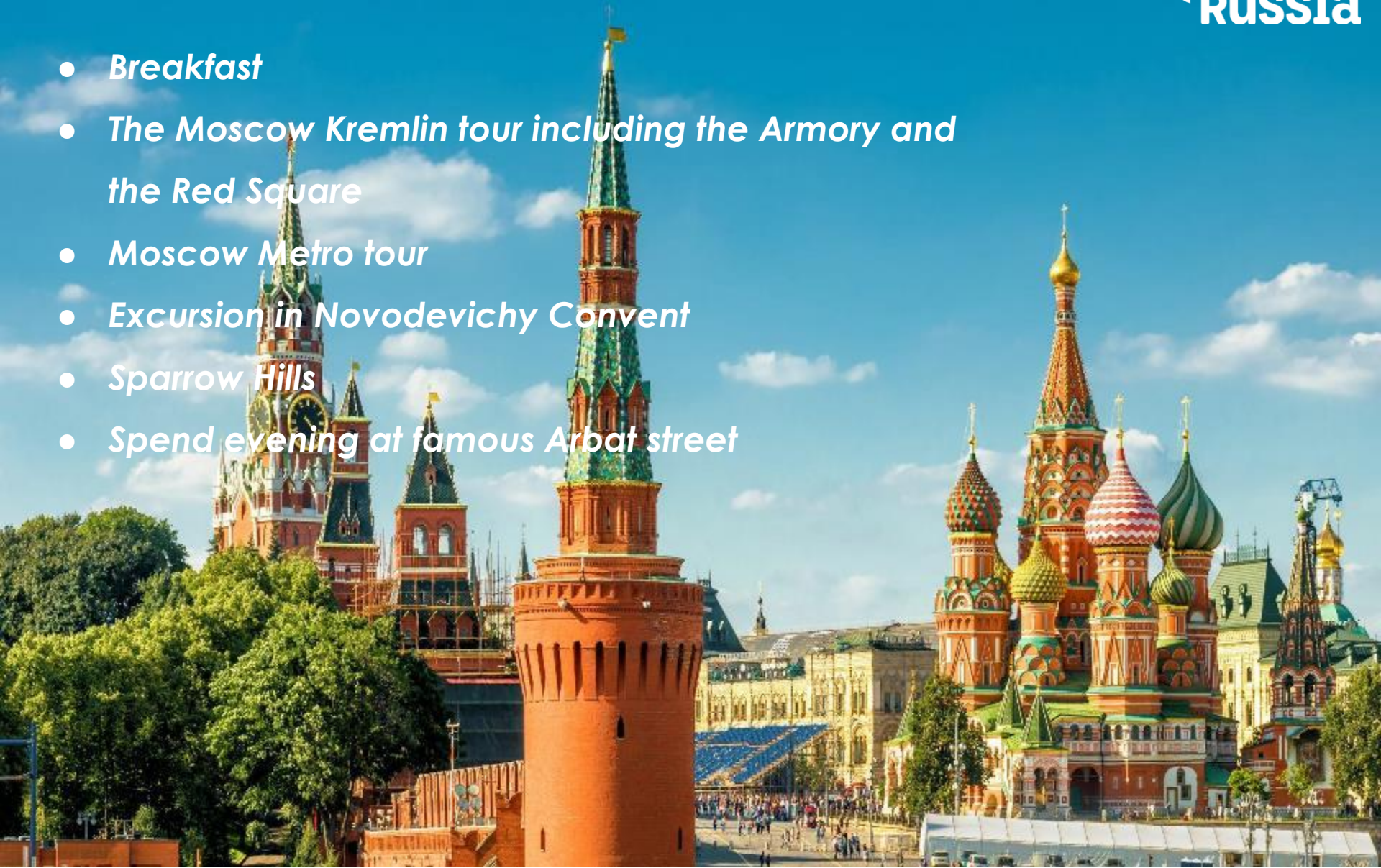



Enjoy a guided visit to the Moscow Kremlin, and see all the treasures of the famous museums. "Kremlin" is not actually a specific place name, but means "fortress". The most well-known kremlin is of course the one in Moscow at Red Square.

And Red Square is not actually Red because of the red bricks, but because "red" in the old Russian language meant "beautiful". And "Kremlin" meant a castle. So, there are many kremlins in Russia and in Moscow alone we will show you a few!

Get to know the city by taking a metro ride to the place of your first visit. The Metro is one of the fastest ways to get anywhere in this city, and to avoid traffic jams. Metro is the fastest ways to get anywhere in this city, and to avoid traffic jams.

Excursion in Novodevichy Convent



Novodevichy Convent, also known as Bogoroditse-Smolensky Monastery is probably the best-known cloister of Moscow. Its name, sometimes translated as the New Maidens' Monastery, was devised to differ from the Old Maidens' Monastery within the Moscow Kremlin. Unlike other Moscow cloisters, it has remained virtually intact since the 17th century. In 2004, it was proclaimed a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Moscow Metro tour



The Moscow Metro was opened in 1935 with one 11-kilometre (6.8 mi) line and 13 stations, it was the first underground railway system in the Soviet Union. As of 2018, the Moscow Metro excluding the Moscow Central Circle and Moscow Monorail has 224 stations (255 with Moscow Central Circle) and its route length is 381 km (237 mi), making it the fifth longest in the world. The system is mostly underground, with the deepest section 84 metres (276 ft) underground at the Park Pobedy station, one of the world's deepest. It's the busiest metro system in Europe, and a tourist attraction in itself.

The VDNKH (“Vystavka Dostizheniy Narodnogo Khozyaystva”—the “All-Russia Exhibition Centre”) complex was built to be an exhibition centre of the entire USSR.

Today it is a remarkable place to visit with lots of museums, amazing buildings, the modern art exhibition centre and the Museum of Cosmonautics.

A remarkable feature of Stalin's era are the so-called "Stalin's skyscrapers", each built in different areas of the city, following common principles of design, but all very different from each other. One of them is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, another is a hotel, a third the Moscow State University, etc! Every building has its own story—and its own famous residents.

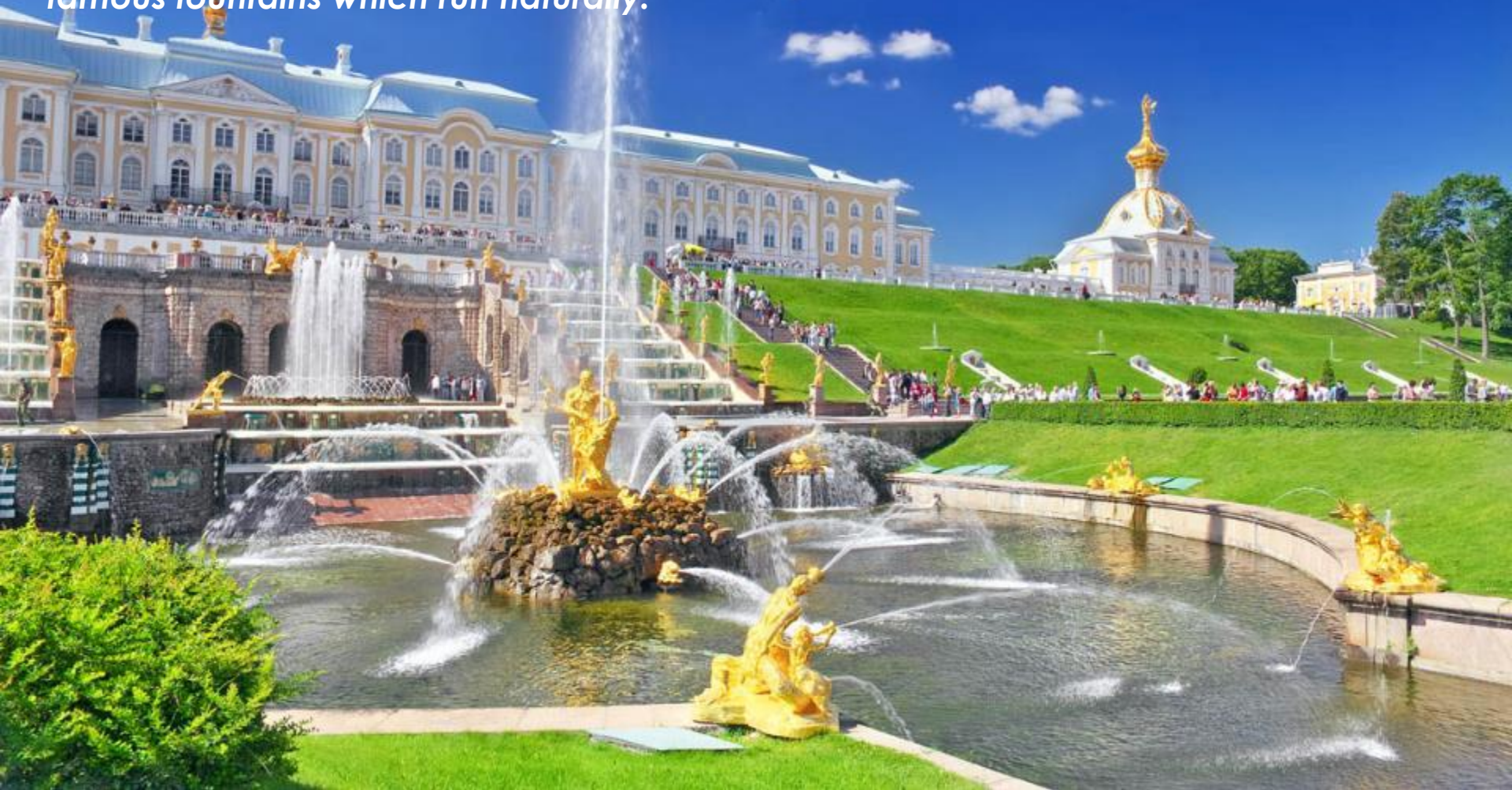

Your guide will take you for a lunch in a local bistro, "stolovaya" where you can try traditional Russian food.

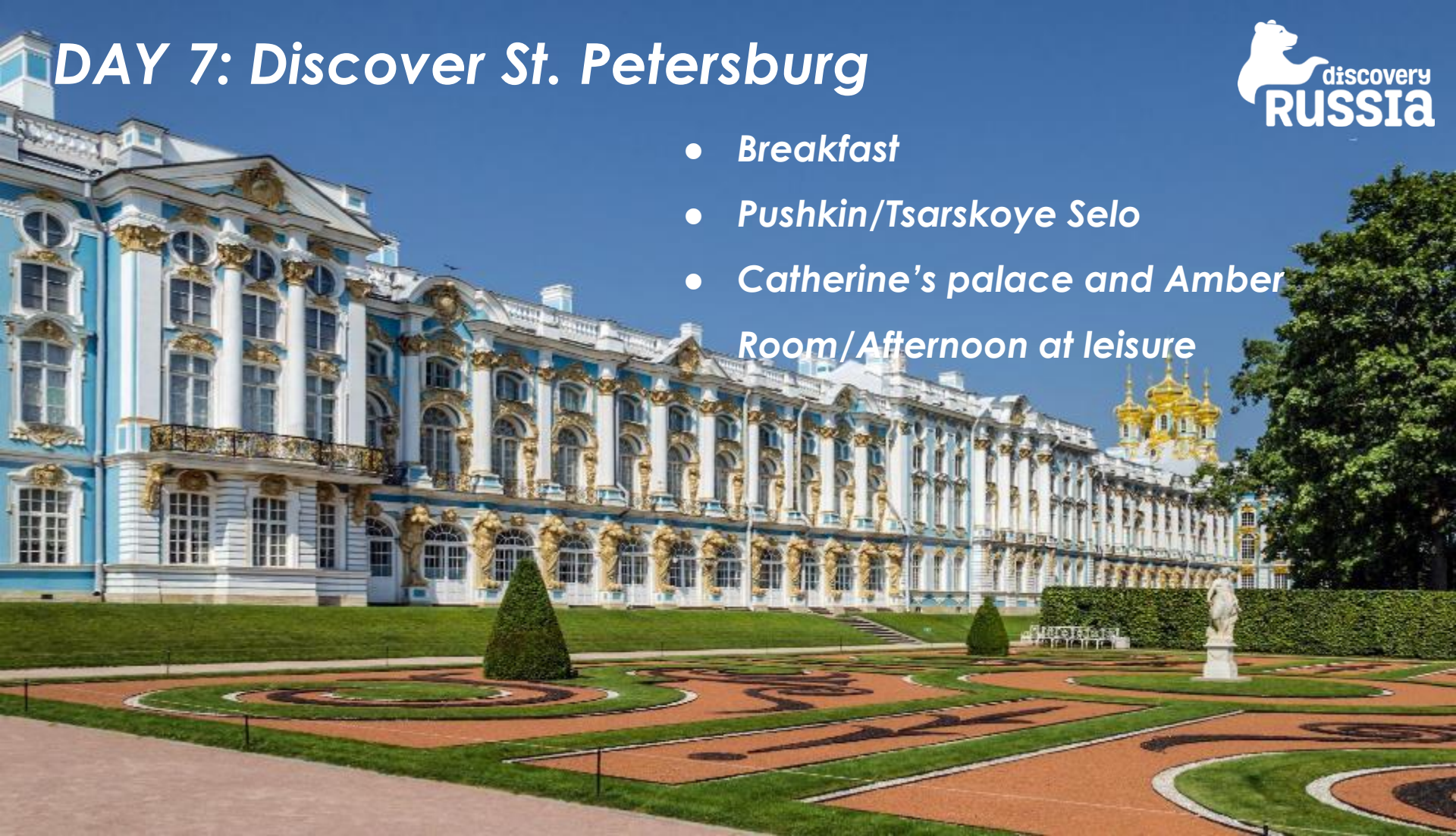
Then, take a tour to see the city's iconic landmark: Isaac Cathedral, Kazan Cathedral, and visit the Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood — one of the most powerful constructions in Russian Orthodox Christian architecture; an absolutely enthralling must-see and a place where Alexander II was fatally wounded by anarchists in 1881.

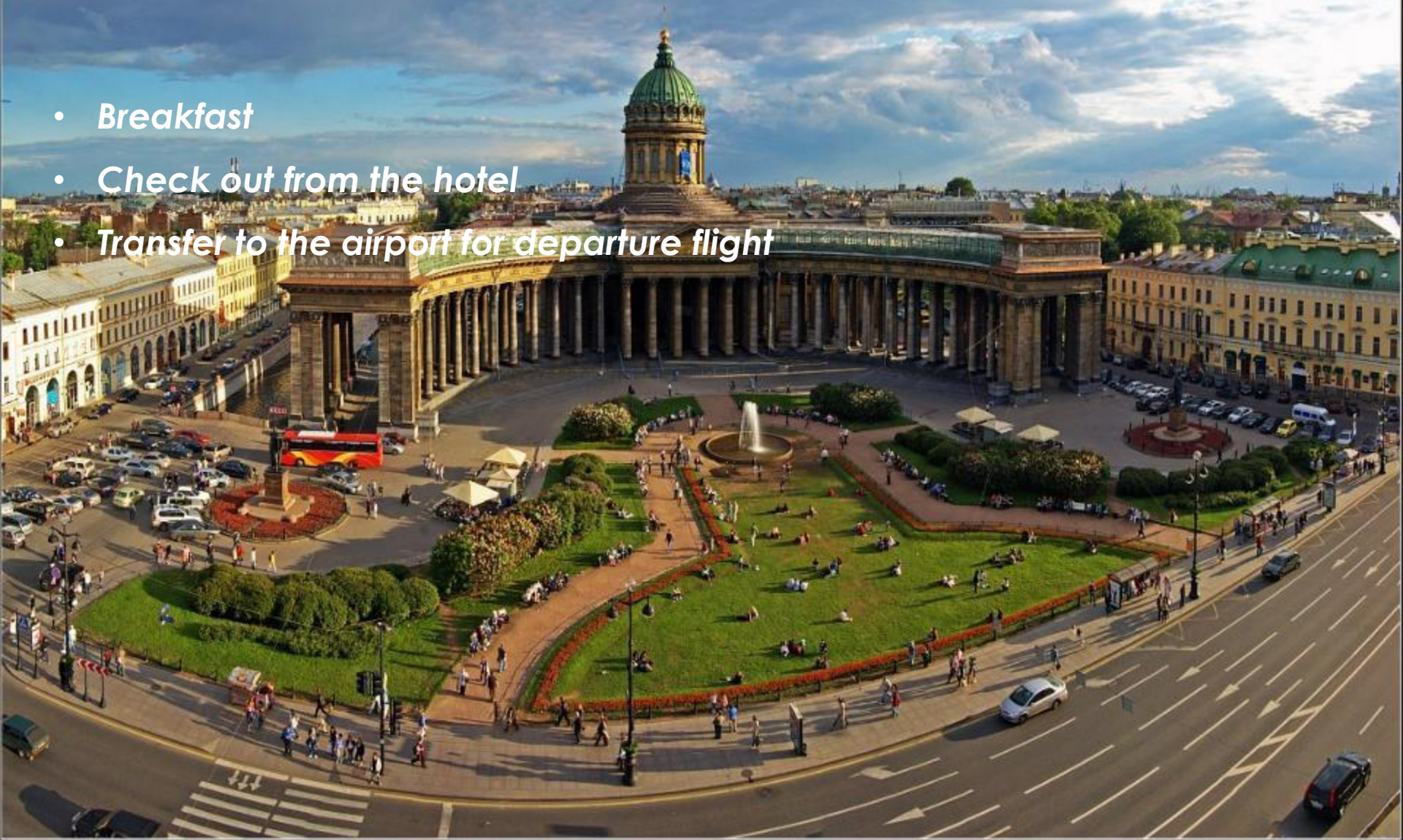

- A Copenhagen Panoramic City Tour with Harbor Cruise. As you cruise through the beautiful city, see impressive monuments like the Gefion Fountain, Rosenborg Castle and the Citadel of Copenhagen.



DAY 11: Discover Copenhagen

→We will then have a 30 minute stop to see the changing of the Royal Guard at Amalienborg Palace. There is also photo stops at both the Opera and the Little Mermaid statue, one of Denmark's most renowned attractions; hear of how the cultural symbol is based on Hans Christian Andersen's timeless tale of the same name.

DAY 12: Copenhagen, Sagnlandet Lejre

Sagnlandet Lejre is an atmospheric and exciting tourist attraction. The unique and controversial experiments involving the reconstruction of houses and agricultural implements from the Iron Age and testing them in practice aroused great public interest. People flocked to the Centre to watch the researchers' efforts as they literally ploughed and chopped new knowledge about ancestors' daily life out of fields and timber.



The basis for experience-oriented communication of the researchers' work was formed and terms such as activating communication and historic workshop teaching arose from the fruitful meeting between learned and layman regardless of sex, age, social and educational background.

DAY 13: Copenhagen, ferry Odden – Aarhus – Aalborg

- Breakfast
- Odden by transfer bus (113 km)
- Then take a ferry to Aarhus. The journey takes 75 minutes.
- At Aarhus Harbour start on a sightseeing tour. Walking tour goes through the old cobbled streets and we suggest you wear comfortable shoes. Plenty of pictures tempting locations, so charge your camera well. On tour, you get to hear stories from the Viking age, middle age, renaissance and up to 19 century, 1974 and get a glimpse of the future that Aarhus has in vision.

DAY 14: Hirsthals - Larvik - Oslo

DAY 15: Discover Oslo

- **A full-day sightseeing tour in Oslo**
- **Travel through the centre of the Norwegian capital and admire popular landmarks such as the medieval Akershus Fortress and Castle, the modern Opera House and the Bar Code area, the City Hall, the main street Karl Johan with the National Theatre, the University, the Royal Palace and much more.**



DAY 15: Discover Oslo



→Continue to the world-renowned Holmenkollen Ski Jump, perched on top of the hill with the same name, one of the city's best vantage points, and enjoy half an hour on your own to explore this beloved recreational area.

→Then head to the magnificent Vigeland Sculpture Park, one of Norway's top attractions, drawing millions of visitors from around the world.

DAY 15: Discover Oslo

- Travel onwards to Bygdøy Peninsula, a picturesque city neighbourhood where some of Oslo's top museums are located
- First, visit the Fram Museum with the polar ship Fram, the strongest wooden vessel in the world that travelled along the Arctic Ocean in the late 1800s and reached the South Pole in 1911. Take a tour of the powerful schooner and learn about the incredible Norwegian polar expeditions.
- Then visit the Viking Ship Museum and marvel at the world's best-preserved Viking ships, more than 1000 years old, and at other original Viking artefacts.
- The evening is free at leisure
- Overnight at the hotel




DAY 16: Oslo - Vinstra

 - Dinner at the Peer Gynt festival grounds
 - After the Festival take a transfer back to our Lodge for overnight

DAY 16: Oslo - Vinstra

"Peer Gynt" that takes place every year in the Gudbrandsdalen valley, is one of Norway's leading cultural festivals. The festival is a celebration of Ibsen's "Peer Gynt" and the historical person Per Gynt, who lived in the Gudbrandsdalen valley. The tales about Per have been told through generations, and these, together with the nature and culture in the valley, is what inspired Henrik Ibsen to write the dramatic poem.

DAY 17: Vinstra - Trondheim

→ Vinstra Railway Station, move to Trondheim (3 hours)

→ Transfer from Trondheim Central Station to the hotel and check-in

→ The evening is free at leisure with optional Trondheim sightseeing tours

→ Overnight at the hotel

DAY 18: Trondheim - Kristiansund - Alesund

- Breakfast
- We head to the harbour (walking distance from the hotel) and take a ferry to Kristiansund (3 hours 30 min) where the transfer bus meets the group to take it to Alesund. The journey will go through the Atlantic road - recognized as one of the most beautiful roads in the World - and will take 4 hours.
- Arrive at Alesund and check-in at the hotel for overnight.



DAY 18: Trondheim - Kristiansund - Alesund



The Atlantic Road takes you from lush coastal landscapes and heaths to bare rocks along the exposed Hustadvika, where you can see the sun sink into the horizon. This National Tourist Route has been called the world's most beautiful drive and has been voted the "Norwegian construction of the century". The Atlantic Road connects the island of Averøy with the mainland via a series of small islands and islets spanned by a total of eight bridges over 8,274 meters.

DAY 19: Aalesund

- After breakfast, the morning is free at leisure
- After lunch, take a boat tour to Runde, the island of puffins. The island is a popular destination all year round but is spectacular in the summer due to its teeming bird-life. Between 500,000 and 700,000 sea birds inhabit the island in the season, most of them in the cliffs.
- Overnight at the hotel.



DAY 20: Aalesund - Geiranger - Hellesylt - Olden

- Have an early breakfast at the hotel and take a transfer to Geiranger, at 8:39 a.m. (110 km)
- Have lunch at Geiranger with spectacular views over Norway's most beautiful fjord and then take a ferry to Hellesylt
- On arrival in Hellesylt, continue with the same bus (it takes the ferry as well) to Briksdalsbre Glacier
- After visiting glacier drive to the village of Loen
- Overnight at the hotel (only 4* hotel, no matter what hotel option you choose for the whole tour)

DAY 20: Aalesund - Geiranger - Hellesylt - Olden



Briksdal is a scenic wonderland that simply must be shared with others. At centre stage, the magnificent Briksdal Glacier, surrounded by towering mountainsides, cascading waterfall and river, and luxuriant flora. Briksdal Glacier is an arm of the Jostedal Glacier, the largest glacier on the European continent – protected as a national park. The ice colossus is spread over 486 km² and at its deepest point measures 400 m. The highest point is 1950 m.a.s.

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DAY 21: Olden - Loen Skylift - Flåm

→ After breakfast at the hotel, take Loen Skylift that is in a walking distance. Loen Skylift is a spectacular new attraction and adventure arena, at the inner part of the Nordfjord, in the heart of Fjord Norway. A Cable Car will lift you from the fjord to 1011 m. Here you can enjoy the views of the fjord landscape - from the restaurant table, or while exploring in the mountains.



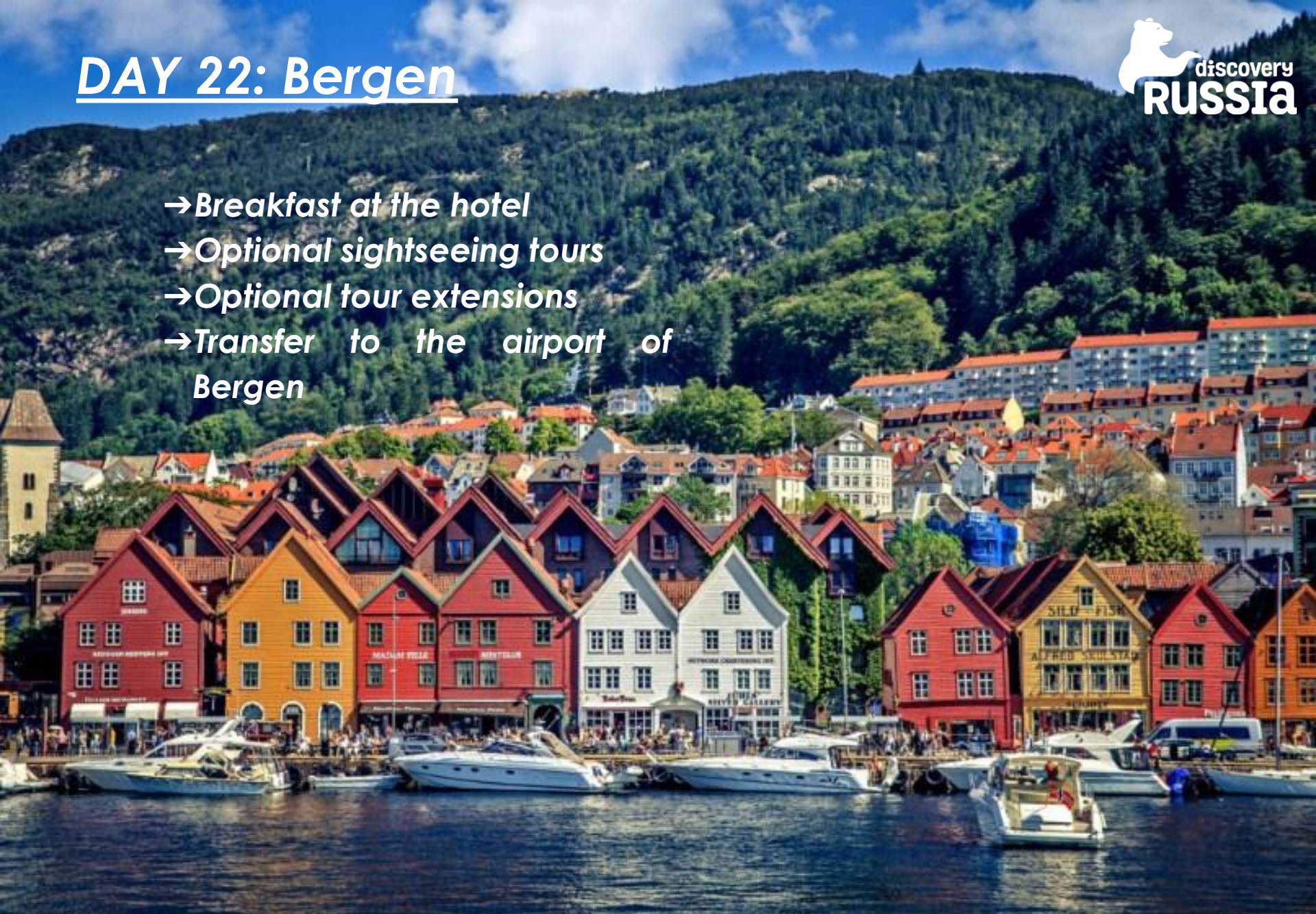
DAY 21: Olden - Loen Skylift - Flåm



- Then drive to Flåm, get off the transfer bus and have a breathtaking journey by Flamsbana. The Flåm Railway has been described as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world and is one of the leading tourist attractions in Norway. The journey features the finest aspects of the stunning scenery of Western Norway. The train runs from the end of Aurlandsfjord, a tributary of the Sognefjord, up to the high mountains at Myrdal station. In Myrdal change the train to get to Bergen in 2 hours.
- Arrive at Bergen, transfer to the hotel and check-in
- The evening is free at leisure with optional sightseeing tours
