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Day 1: Arrive St Petersburg

Welcome to St Petersburg, the Venice of the North!

Founded by the Tsar Peter the Great on the 27th of May 1703, St Petersburg was planned and built as the capital of newly emerged Russian Empire. Today, it is arguably one of the most beautiful cities in Europe and UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Winter is a very special time to Russia and its people. You will see one of the most beautiful cities in the world covered with snow and ice — it feels like you're stepping into a famous Russian novel! See how the locals deal with cold and snow — and participate! Open-air skating, snowball play in the parks, tobogganing down hills, walking along the frozen river banks of the Neva — experience the winter in one of the Snow Empire's two capitals!

Your driver will be waiting at the airport/train station to take you to the cosy hotel in downtown. Afternoon at leisure. Group tours enjoy Welcome Dinner with vodka tasting!





















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Day 2: The Hermitage & Iconic Landmarks

Full-day (8 hours) guided tour in St Petersburg.

Today, you visit one of the most important sites in Russian history and heritage, the world-famous Palace of the **Hermitage**. Our experienced guides will make it interesting to follow the tricky path of the centuries behind it and give a better understanding of sophisticated Russian history. This former residence of the Romanovs Royal Family today is the second-largest art museum in the world; its collection includes over 2.7 mln items.

Then, take a tour to see the city's iconic landmarks: Isaac Cathedral, Kazan Cathedral, Peter and Paul Fortress and cathedral and the Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood — one of the most powerful constructions in Russian Orthodox Christian architecture, and an enthralling must-see.










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Day 4: At Leisure


Today **optional** tours are available: visit Faberge museum, Russian museum or go out of the megapolis to discover Veliky Novgorod.

Veliky Novgorod was Russia's first capital in the 9th century, as well as a centre for Orthodox spirituality, Russian democracy, literacy and architecture. The city boasts medieval monuments, churches and monasteries. Veliky Novgorod is the place to discover the richness of Russia's great and glorious history and the touch of the living antiquity. The ancient lands of Novgorod, the birthplace of Russia, is a must-see for a discerning traveller.

In the evening, enjoy folk show "Feel Yourself Russian" with dinner at the Nikolaevsky Palace (optional). It is a unique performance, which allows feeling the history and soul of Russia. The classical music, performed by the quartet "Classique", create the gorgeous atmosphere of the XIX century.





















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Day 5: Arrive Moscow // Start of **Moscow to Vladivostok tour**

A tour to Russia is not complete without a tour to Moscow, the heart of Russia and one of the oldest cities in the country. It was founded in 1147th. Now Moscow is a city of bright contrasts where quiet patriarchal courts and small streets adjoin to futuristic business centres, and old neighbourhoods are interspersed with modern high-rises.

After check out of the hotel in St Petersburg, you will be transferred to the railway station to board high-speed train for 4 hours journey to Moscow. On arrival at Moscow, take a transfer to your hotel and check-in.





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Day 7: Moscow Tour

Full-day (8 hours) guided tour in Moscow.

A short ride from the city centre will take you to **Kolomenskoe** Museum-Reserve, where you can get an idea of what Medieval Moscow looked like. You'll find the oldest garden in Moscow and a favourite estate of Tsar Alexey Mikhailovich, father of Peter the Great.

Today, visit the **State Tretyakov Art Gallery**, the foremost depository of Russian fine art in the world. The collection contains more than 130,000 exhibits, ranging from Theotokos of Vladimir and Andrei Rublev's Trinity to the monumental Composition VII by Wassily Kandinsky and the Black Square by Kazimir Malevich. *(not available on 1 January and will be replaced with another activity)

During the tour, you also take a ride by the famous Moscow metro.

In the evening, transfer to the train station to board the overnight train to Kazan.







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Day 8: Discover Kazan

Early morning arrival at Kazan and guaranteed early check-in.

Today we have a really busy day to explore the main sights of Kazan. First of all, enjoy the tour to UNESCO World Heritage Site, **the Kremlin of Kazan** with the professional English-speaking guide.

Our next point is the magnificent **Kul Sharif Mosque**. The impressive Qol-Şärif Mosque (also transliterated as Kul-Sharif) is the most important mosque in Tatarstan and one of the largest mosques in Europe.


As Kazan is the centre of Tatar culture, we will also visit the **old Tatar village** to try a local Tatar tea. Later, have a master **cooking class** of Tatar dishes at a traditional restaurant.

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Day 9: Arrive Yekaterinburg


Early check-out and transfer to the train station to board the train to Yekaterinburg.

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Day 11: Across Siberia

Midnight check out of the hotel. Transfer to the train station to board the train to Irkutsk.

There are many trains going eastbound and westbound. You will be surprised by the scale of the system connecting together the world's largest country, thus being a bridge between Asia and Europe. The entire system works like a Swiss watch!

Wintertime transforms familiar landscapes, and there's no better way to see Russia's wild side while staying warm. The train stops at all the major destinations across Russia, and our flexible travel packages mean that you can get out and explore.





















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Day 12: The Journey Goes On

A long train journey is a fine opportunity to relax and calm down. Read the favorite book, talk to fellow travelers and enjoy unique landscapes of the snow empire behind your window.

This train experience will last for 2 days. Each train is equipped with a dining-car where you will be able to have a rest at any time. But nevertheless, we advise to get some food in advance.

Russian branded trains offer a high standard of service, design, comfort and additional services. Most trains are air-conditioned and have electric heating and TVs. Some also have Internet connections and cable television. Discovery Russia uses the best available trains for each leg of your train journey.

Staff is always available to offer passengers hot tea or coffee, make the beds, provide all necessary information en route and hand out periodicals and safety belts to passengers.





















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Day 13: Taltsy Museum

Get the essential winter Siberian vibe, welcome to Irkutsk! Take a short guided city tour to explore the main highlights. Then take a transfer to Listvyanka village. Prepare to see the world-famous Lake Baikal!

But first, make a stop at **Taltsy Open Air Siberian** Museum. Taltsy is located 20 kilometers away from Listvyanka. The exposition features wooden buildings brought from all over Siberia! Right now, 40 landmarked buildings and 8000 artifacts dated by XVII-XIX centuries are presented as part of the exhibition. Here you will see the traditional folk-show and have a lunch.

In the afternoon, we will arrive at Listvyanka and finally see Lake Baikal. It is the deepest, largest and, possibly, the most ancient freshwater lake in the world which contains 20% of Earth's fresh water. At this time, it's covered by a famous turquoise ice. You can walk, run or even drive on the water now (weather permitting).





















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Day 15: Siberian Winter Fun

Today we have a very special activity planned: a dog sledding tour with hot picnic lunch in the heart of Siberia, an experience not to be missed! It is one of the favourite winter activities in cold Siberia. This activity is suitable for any age and level of fitness.

Then take a transfer back to Irkutsk and check -in.

Enjoy city walk with the guide and explore the beautiful winter city. Irkutsk was founded in the middle of the XVII century. One of Russia's most acclaimed authors, Anton Chekhov, referred to it as the Paris of Siberia. The town is famous for its wooden houses and wooden lace perfectly preserved. In fact, the Irkutsk historic centre is one huge open-air museum!

We visit Decembrist Museum to learn about the 30-year long exile in Siberia after the 1825 riot This exile influenced development of Siberia as many famous and noble names of that time were in attendance. In the evening, board the train to Vladivostok/or overnight in the city - subject to trains schedule





















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Day 16-18: On Board to the Far East

We move forward. Take a transfer to the train station and board the train to Vladivostok. Enjoy a more leisurely pace next three days as we travel through the beautiful winter landscape of Russia.

The Russian Far East is extraordinarily far from Russia's major population centres in Europe and is usually visited separately unless... by the Trans-Siberian Railway of course. The largest city in the region, Vladivostok, is a full seven time zones away from Moscow, with 9,300 km of railroad between them.

NB: our professional guides will assist at every train station with stocking necessary snacks before each leg of the train ride and use our Trans-Siberian Manuals to pack properly. You will find it to be pretty comfortable journey.





















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Day 19: Arrive Vladivostok and Tour

Welcome to the capital of Primorye!

Your driver will be waiting at train station to take you to the cosy hotel in downtown for guaranteed early check in

Full day (6 hours) guided tour in Vladivostok.

Vladivostok started to grow with the Trans Siberian when the construction commenced in 1891. Amazing landscapes, the ocean, historical sightseeing, naval base, active marine sports, seafood - everyone will find something appealing here, at the eastern side of Russia.

Today you will visit all major highlights: harbour, Submarine S-56, view point Eagle's Nest, Vokzalnaya Square, the monument of the Trans-Siberian Railway, Russky Island.

One of the highlights of the tour is of course Golden Bridge, an astonishing cable-stayed bridge across the Zolotoy Rog (Golden Horn). It is considered the world's 12th longest cable-stayed bridge.



Day 20: Farewell

After breakfast, take a private transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
